As result of the Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) reauthorization in 2008 a new type of higher education program for students with intellectual disabilities titled: Comprehensive Transition Programs or CTPs were established. Institutions of Higher Education may submit an application to the US Department of Education to become a CTP.

CCS@TCNJ is one of the first colleges in the Nation to be awarded the status as a CTP. As a recognized CTP, a college program can accept students that are currently completing their post-secondary special education programs through their local school district. Currently, there are approximately 275 Higher Education Programs across the United States and 61 CTPs in 24 States.

This workshop is intended to provide an overview of the current National Trends in Post-Secondary Inclusive College & Transition Programs; The implementation of Student Based Futures Planning for Youth with Intellectual Disabilities (*Carole Gothelf, Director of Individualized Supports, AHRC, New York City*) and an Overview of the CCS@TCNJ Program (*CCS Staff/Faculty.*)
